Dear OnePlusGod family,

We can only give praise to our Father for an extremely blessed 2016! This year marks the 3rd year of ministry, serving people here in America especially through our retreats, missions events and teaching, but also through short-term trips and projects in Haiti, Jamaica, South Africa, Papua and Thailand...with on the horizon Mali and Burkina Faso!

The combination of trips, retreats, missions events and teaching had proven by God's grace to help us lead our ministry partners to all become more and more missions minded in everything we do...every day, everywhere!

During 2016 we had sent our first group of college students on a Spring-break trip to Jamaica and also had for the first time two groups going to Haiti in one year. This was also the first year to add a tour of the Holy Land!

2016 was also filled with some great retreats and events: We kicked off with a couples retreat, followed by one for the men in Spring, a family retreat in the Fall and a women's retreat in the Winter! All events came to a celebrating end during our Christmas event at the end of the year!

Except for reaching out with the Good News, and financially supporting missionaries in SA, Papua, Thailand and Haiti, we also helped to get pastor Ben's car repaired in Bangkok, we added the salaries of two new missionaries in Bangkok (Koh and Nid), helped a missions' kid, Mercy, with her school fees, gave the seed money to get an English Center and a Thai-missions Foundation started in Bangkok, raised funds to bring pastor Annalie from SA to the States for support raising, and helped her to get her car repaired, send the kids from the Daycare in SA to the zoo for the first time in their lives, provided special, indestructible soccer balls to SA and Haiti, and then in Haiti too we got land purchased so that we could start with getting a church and school build in the village of Dumay, and we got our Haitian missionaries' truck repaired too—seems like we got a lot of missions' vehicles back on the road in 2016! It was also a privilege to have spread hundreds of Bibles, preach, teach and share the Gospel to hundreds of people over multiple countries!

All was, is and will be to the glory of our God!

FINANCIAL SPOTLIGHT

OnePlusGod Ministries employees raise their own support, enabling the ministry to provide teaching for free, retreats under cost, and mission trips that simply covers cost. We want to praise our Father that this financial strategy had sustained and grown the ministry over these first 3 years.

Let's take a closer look into 2016

- Total revenue: We grew from \$199,931 in 2015 to \$365,102 in 2016.
- \$292,094 in support went to our missionaries.
- \$38,343 was spent on mission trips.
- \$607 went to retreats.
- \$34,058 kept our staff and admin going.
