

of sticks on either side! "Maybe I should bring them my set when I come again."


This thought surprised him. He had never thought of giving any of his toys away before!

South Africa

There are eleven official languages in South Africa, including Afrikaans, English, Ndebele, Pedi, Sotho, Swazi, Tsonga, Tswana, Venda, Xhosa and Zulu.

South Africa is divided into 9 provinces and has three capital cities: Cape Town (the legislative capital), Pretoria (the administrative capital) and Bloemfontein (the judicial capital).

South Africa is home to the big five: Elephants, Leopards, Rhinos, Buffalos, and Lions.

The third longest coastline of Africa is South Africa's (1,739 miles). The country occupies the southern tip of the African continent, and most of it is semi-arid climate.

South Africa is 470,693 square miles – slightly less than twice the size of Texas.

Famous people from South Africa: late former president Nelson Mandela, actress Charlize Theron and the author of *Lord of the Rings*, JRR Tolkien.
